- Autonomy describes our desire to rule ourselves as a result of the fall. In what ways do you see expressions of self-protection and self-promotion in your life? How are you tempted to orient your life around meeting your own needs?
- How does our autonomy limit our spiritual power and effectiveness?
- What is at stake if we don't live out our calling?
- How does God, who is your Ezer, comfort and equip you to live as an ezer? How does this robust picture of what it means to be an ezer reframe your view of what it means to be a woman? For further understanding of how God functions as our Ezer, read Psalm 146.
- What traits and experiences are captured by our individuality?
- Why has God given us spiritual gifts?
- What does your current season look like? What happens when we over identify with a past season or role?
- How does the ezer model that describes our calling, individuality, and season give us both clarity and freedom in what it means to be a woman?
